

# PRIVACY POLICY

## Information on data protection

AMS Europe e.V. (“**AMS Europe**“) informs you that AMS Europe processes your contact data within the scope of its activities:

1) **Name and contact data of the Controller:**

2) **Purposes of processing and legal basis:**

AMS Europe processes your contact data for internal administrative and business purposes. AMS EUROPE needs the contact details in order to carry out its activities, in particular to contact you and your company, which is or would like to become a member of AMS EUROPE. Furthermore, AMS EUROPE needs the contact details to inform you about its activities and to carry out meetings and events.

The processing of data is necessary to enable AMS EUROPE to protect its legitimate interests. The processing of the data is permitted in accordance with Article 6(1)f GDPR.

3) **Recipients:**

AMS EUROPE will not transmit your contact data to third parties without your consent.

However, AMS EUROPE uses various service providers (Processors) for its IT systems, who may have access to the data (IT maintenance/cloud services). However, these service providers may only process the data at the instructions of AMS EUROPE.

4) **Duration of storage:**

AMS EUROPE stores your contact data for as long as your company is a member of AMS EUROPE. AMS EUROPE shall also keep data available thereafter if it is obliged to store the data due to statutory retention periods. The legal retention periods are six years according to § 257 HGB and ten years according to § 147 AO.

5) **Your rights:**

If the legal prerequisites are met, you have the following rights in accordance with Articles 15 to 22 GDPR: right to information, rectification, erasure, restriction of processing, object and the right of data portability.

6) **Right to lodge objection with the supervisory authority:**

You have the right to complain to the supervisory authority in accordance with Article 77 GDPR if you believe that the processing of your personal data is not lawful. The address of the supervisory authority responsible for AMS EUROPE is:
